



THE CUF COMMUNITY FUND (aka Tower Fund)

The CUF Community Fund is a non-profit corporation organized exclusively for charitable purposes, including but not limited to, acquisition, receipt, management and investments of funds and the distribution of all or any part of the earnings or income therefrom only (not principal or corpus) for those projects the Trustees feel best achieve the goals of the CUF Community Plan, dated December 1984, as the same may from time to time be changed.

A board of five Trustees, elected from membership of the CUF Neighborhood Association manages the Fund. The goals of the Fund, and the criteria for the distribution of grants and income shall be:

- A. The preservation and promotion of resident ownership in the CUF neighborhood;
- B. The promotion of residential stability in the CUF neighborhood;
- C. The beautification of the CUF neighborhood environment;
- D. The promotion of the quality of life in the CUF neighborhood;
- E. The promotion of zoning that encourages and promotes owner occupancy of low-density residential property in the CUF neighborhood;
- F. The protection of the CUF neighborhood from the encroachment of commercial, high density residential, and institutional activity and development;
- G. The continuing existence and vitality of CUF Neighborhood Association or its successor organization.
